

Maintenance Mechanic I

Perform general maintenance of our properties, including carpentry, flooring, electrical, plumbing patching, painting, appliance repair, grounds work, snow removal, unit inspections, construction monitoring, room setups for events, and sheetrock repair.

Essential Job Functions

- Execute preventive maintenance and routine engineering checks in all mechanical and boiler rooms; maintains logs, work orders, and other required documentation, including but not limited to RealPage Facilities software
- Prepare vacant apartments for new residents and refreshes apartment units as needed
- Perform unit inspections to ensure building/unit integrity, safety, and compliance to inspection mandates
- Carry out routine engineering checks in all mechanical and boiler rooms
- Document time in/time out or other tracking system functions on all work orders
- Perform grounds maintenance duties, such as mowing, weeding, snow and ice removal
- Must be available to respond when assigned to evening, weekend, and holiday emergency coverage for emergency mechanical/technical services.(Rotating responsibility with other team members)
